# CRITERIA & CONDITIONS FOR DANCE COMPETITION:

Categories: Solo, Duet, Group.

Time Limit: Each individual/team will be given a certain amount of time ( will be informed later) to perform.

Music: The music used in the performance must be appropriate for all age groups and should not contain any vulgar, obscene or offensive language.

Props: The use of props is allowed but must be taken care of by the participants itself.

Costumes: The costumes worn must be appropriate and in good taste.

Judging Criteria: The performances will be judged on the basis of choreography, synchronization, creativity, stage presence, costume, music, and overall impact.

Prizes: The best performance will be awarded prizes and certificates. The decision of the judges will be final and binding.

All the participants should register beforehand.

The competition will be held in front of a live audience, and participants must be ready to perform at their designated time.

All participants must follow the code of conduct and ethical behavior.







Unleash your inner fashionista at Spandana! Strut your style and showcase your creativity on the runway.

The time limit for the walk is 1-2 minutes.

The use of any provocative or revealing clothing is strictly prohibited. All clothing should be decent and appropriate for a family-friendly event.

Participants must bring their own clothing, accessories, and footwear. Any props required for the presentation must be arranged by the participants.

The organizing team will provide the music.

Participants will be judged based on factors such as creativity, presentation, confidence, and stage presence.

The decision of the judges will be final and binding.



Each participant is allowed to perform one standup act that must be their original work. No plagiarism is allowed.

The act duration will be informed later.

The participants will be judged on the basis of their originality, content, delivery, and stage presence.

The judge's decision will be final and binding.

The use of any vulgar or offensive language or material will lead to immediate disqualification.

Participants should dress appropriately and must not indulge in any behavior that may be deemed inappropriate.

The competition is meant to be a fun and lighthearted event, so keep your content clean and positive.

Use humor to address social issues, but avoid any content that may be deemed offensive to any community or group.

Remember to respect other participants and their performances.

# CRITERIA & GUIDELINES FOR SINGING COMPETITION:

CATEGORIES: SOLO, DUET AND GROUP

THE SONGS CHOSEN BY THE PARTICIPANTS MUST BE APPROPRIATE FOR ALL AUDIENCES AND SHOULD NOT CONTAIN ANY OFFENSIVE LANGUAGE OR THEMES.

THE PARTICIPANTS SHOULD DRESS APPROPRIATELY FOR THE PERFORMANCE AND SHOULD NOT WEAR REVEALING OR OFFENSIVE CLOTHING.

THE PARTICIPANTS SHOULD BE AWARE OF THEIR STAGE PRESENCE AND BODY LANGUAGE DURING THE PERFORMANCE.

ANY KIND OF PRE-RECORDED MUSIC OR SOUND EFFECTS ARE ALLOWED, BUT NEEDED TO INFORMED TO THE ORGANIZING COMMITTEE IN ADVANCE.

EACH PARTICIPANT OR GROUP MAY ONLY PERFORM ONE SONG FOR THE COMPETITION.

THE MAXIMUM TIME LIMIT FOR PERFORMANCE WILL BE INFORMED LATER.

THE JUDGING PANEL DECISIONS WILL BE FINAL.

THE PARTICIPANTS OR GROUPS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING THEIR OWN MUSICAL ACCOMPANIMENT OR INSTRUMENTALISTS.

WINNERS WILL BE ANNOUNCED ON THE LAST SEGMENT OF THE COLLEGE FEST AND AWARDED WITH PRIZES AND CERTIFICATES.



Each band can have a maximum of 18 members, including vocalists and instrumentalists.

The performance must be between 8-15 minutes long.

The use of pre-recorded tracks or samples is strictly prohibited.

Bands must bring their own instruments, including drum kits and amplifiers. The organizers will provide a basic sound setup.

The content of the performance must be appropriate for a family-friendly event. Any explicit or offensive content will be avoided.

Bands will be judged based on factors such as musicianship, stage presence, and audience engagement.

The decision of the judges will be final and binding.

Registration must be done in advance and a confirmation email will be sent to the selected participants.



Only original poems will be accepted. Any form of plagiarism will result in disqualification.

Each participant can recite only one poem for the competition.

The poem can be on any topic, but it should be appropriate for a college audience.

The maximum length of the poem should be 40 lines.


The decision of the judges will be final and binding.

Each team can have a maximum of 20 participants, including actors, helping members, and musicians.

The performance should be no longer than 15 minutes, with a 2-minute grace period for setup and takedown. (Tentatively)

Teams must bring their own props and costumes. However, the use of fire, explosives, and any other hazardous materials is strictly prohibited.

The script, dialogue, and actions of the performance should be in good taste and should not hurt the sentiments of any individual or group.

The theme of the street play/drama should be in line with the overall theme of Spandana, which is promoting unity in diversity, social awareness, equality, and empowerment.

The performance should be engaging, creative, and visually appealing, with appropriate use of music and sound effects.

The story should be well-crafted, with a clear beginning, middle, and end. The message should be delivered in a subtle but impactful way.

The performances will be judged on various parameters, including acting skills, stage presence, creativity, and overall impact.

The judge's decision will be final and binding, and no objections or complaints will be entertained.
